Guild to Sponsor Hot Springs Concert Band Event



The HS/HSV Symphony Guild is sponsoring *On Broadway!* the July 23 Hot Springs Concert Band’s free concert in Whittington Park. The concert starts at 6:30 p.m. As part of the Band’s *Taking the Music to the People* free summer series, every song is from a great Broadway show.

The medley *Bright Lights on Broadway* will feature two tunes associated with the late, great Ethel Merman: Irving Berlin’s 1954 hit, *There’s No Business Like Show Business*, and *Everything’s Coming up Roses* from the 1959 musical, *Gypsy*. From Meredith Wilson’s unforgettable *The Music Man* (1962), you’ll picture flimflam man Harold Hill leading the boys’ band down the streets of town as the Band plays *Seventy-Six Trombones*. In 1969, Lucille Ball starred in her only Broadway production, *Wildcat*. The Band’s tribute to that famous redhead is *Hey, Look Me Over*. An entire medley is dedicated to the music of Cole Porter’, presenting snippets of nine songs in six and a half minutes. From Porter’s first Broadway success, 1928’s *Paris*, you’ll hear *Let’s Do It (Let’s Fall in Love)*. From his 1932 musical, *Gay Divorcee*, comes the beloved *Night and Day*. An-

ething Goes from the 1934 musical of the same name pokes fun at the Depression-era high-society scandals.

The Concert Band invites audiences to bring lawn chairs, coolers with cold drinks and sandwiches, and bug spray to fully enjoy the concert. Feather boas, dancing shoes, and strands of pearls are optional.

Guild Membership Drive Is Underway




